In an effort to improve the mail order pharmacy service you receive, we are pleased to announce **American Diversified Pharmacies (ADP)**, a state-of-the-art mail order facility to fill your prescription needs. This does not affect your prescription drug benefits and you can expect to pay the same copay amount for your mail service prescriptions as you currently pay.

Effective **September 1, 2006** your mail order prescriptions with existing **REFILLS** will be automatically transferred from your current mail order pharmacy and filled exclusively using American Diversified Pharmacies (ADP). No further action is required on your part.

Ordering your next prescription from ADP mail order pharmacy is easy. Simply call **1-877-889-3402** toll-free and our Customer Service Help Desk will be glad to assist you 24 hrs a day, 7 days a week. Or, you can use any of these other convenient ordering options listed below:

How to use the mail order service

- Have your doctor write the prescription for up to a 90-day supply, with the appropriate refills.
- Mail your prescription, copay and the mail order form to ADP. Mail order forms can be obtained from the Fund office.
- Allow up to 14 days to receive your order.
