

Summary of New RxAmerica Prescription Drug Programs (Indemnity Plan Enrollees Only)

3 For Free Program – Depression / High Cholesterol

Program start date: 8/1/08

Program end date: 10/31/08

Program details: Get a \$0 copay when you switch to, or are currently taking one of the preferred generic/OTC drugs, for Depression and High Cholesterol. You must consult your doctor for appropriateness and obtain a new prescription for the generic medication. Then fill the prescription during the allotted time frame and receive your prescription at a \$0 copay.

Medications:

Switching from; Crestor 5mg, Lipitor 10mg or 20mg, Lexapro, Effexor XR.

Switching to; simvastatin, generic Zocor, lovastatin, pravastatin, citalopram/generic Celexa, fluoxetine/generic Prozac, paroxetine/generic Paxil, sertraline/generic Zoloft, venlafaxine/generic Effexor

Specialty Medication Program

Program start date: 9/1/08

Program details: RxAmerica's Specialty program provides one-on-one service and active management of Biopharmaceuticals. This program provides a more cost effective solution for specialty medications. A Member care specialist will be assigned to contact individuals who have been prescribed certain medications to make sure that they are taking them, as prescribed, and understand how to deal with any side effects that may occur. These medications are sent directly to the members' homes and clinical pharmacists that are dedicated to the specialty pharmacy are available on a 24 hour basis to answer questions or concerns. *A list of specialty medications will be provided before the September 1st implementation date.*
